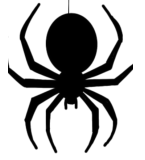
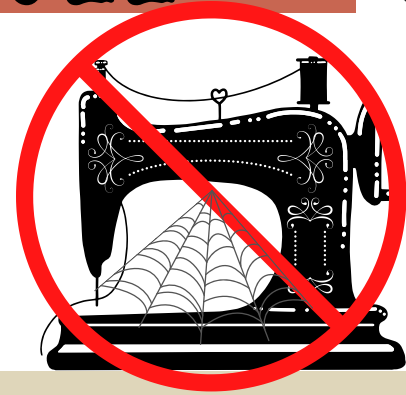

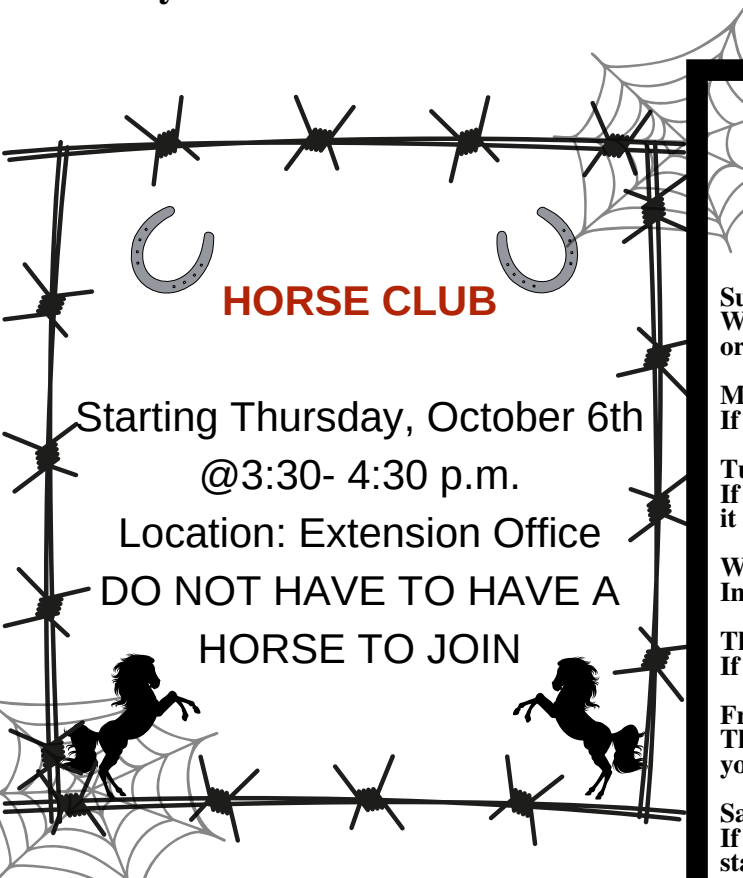
CANDY DONATIONS

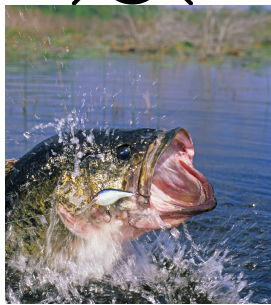

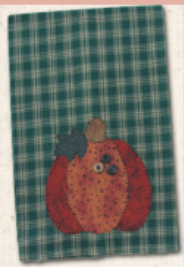
