


Spring Harvest Salad

5 cups torn spring leaf lettuce

21/2 cups spinach leaves

11/2 cups sliced strawberries

1 cup fresh blueberries

1/2 cup thinly sliced green onions

 Combine leaf lettuce and spinach leaves with sliced strawberries, blueberries and green onion in a large salad bowl.

2. Prepare dressing by whisking together the lemon juice, olive oil,

Dressing:

4 teaspoons lemon juice honey

2½ tablespoons olive

1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar

11/2 teaspoons Dijon mustard

balsamic vinegar, Dijon mustard, honey and salt; **pour** over lettuce mixture and toss to coat.

Sprinkle salad with feta cheese and sliced almonds.

Serve immediately.

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 cup feta cheese crumbles

1/2 cup unsalted sliced almonds
