HANDLE THE CHICKS THE RIGHT WAY!

- ▶ Only handle one chick at a time.
- ▶ Hold the chick with both hands, but do not squeeze.
- ▶ Keep your face away from the chick.
- ▶ Keep your hands away from your face, mouth and eyes while you are handling the chicks.
- ▶ Keep hands away from face, mouth and eyes until you have properly washed your hands.

▶ Wash your hands or use a hand sanitizer.
